Dear Friend of Loon Lake,

**Anderson Meadow Wetland** shown below is the last, big, critically important wetland for the health and cleansing of our entire lake! **GOOD NEWS**...Thanks to many of you, the Conservancy was able to act quickly during October when the east half of the entire Anderson Meadow came up for sale.



Thanks especially to some major donors from Silver Beach, North Shore, and Sunset Beach, we were able to quickly fundraise \$230,000 to acquire 2 parcels representing 250 ft of waterfront and 40 acres behind in the meadow as well as another 20 acres of timbered snow and rain saving/cleansing upland drainage.

And we are hoping to be able to also acquire another 150 ft of waterfront and 20 acres behind in the meadow. To save this third parcel we will need your help in raising the \$135,000 purchase price.

**Shawl Wetland** near Shore Acres Estates...**MORE GOOD NEWS**...thanks to all our donors, we've now completed pay off of this additional 100 ft of waterfront and 20 acres timbered drainage into the Shawl Wetland. **Thank you Donors, Volunteers, and all our Supporters!**

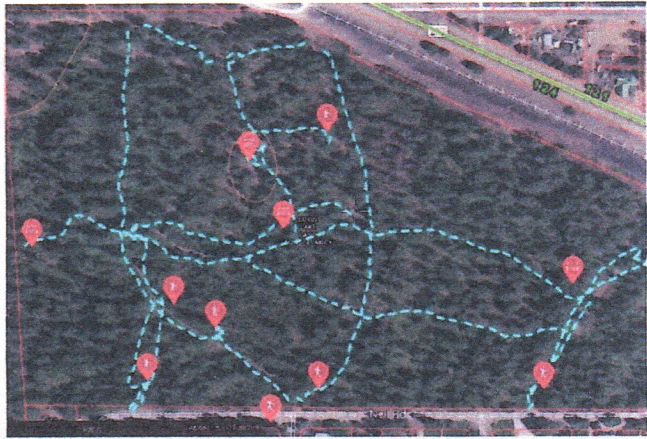
