Accomplishments of Your Conservancy During 2019...

- ❖ Your Conservancy was able to complete the **Morgan Wood Fire Reduction project**, re-establish entrances and trails with the help of 24 Volunteers, and prepare this 40 acres for our continued enjoyment well into the future.
- ❖ **Loon Lake Centennial Park** was Cleaned Up and Maintained through the summer thanks to 15 Volunteers hard work.
- ❖ The 20 acre and 400' of shoreline **Shawl Wetland(part of Anderson Meadow)**purchase of 2017 was paid off thanks to donor responses to our summer fundraising events: our Summer Appeal letter, the late July "Float In", and a major donor event in August... "Summer's Eve on the Lawn"... which together raised the final \$40,000 needed!
- ❖ A **Clean-up and Trails Day at the Shawl Wetland** recruited over 23 Volunteers from Shore Acres Estates and the Conservancy Board to enjoy accomplishing much work in little time!
- ❖ Finally, in a late September 2019 surprise, we learned that if we acted quickly we might acquire **another 100' of shoreline wetland and 20 acre upland adjacent to the south side of the Shawl Wetland**. Again, Conservancy Board members and friends from the Shore Acres Estates community helped to quickly raise 75% of the needed funds to capture this added piece of filtering wetland for the future of our lake. We continue to seek the remaining \$25,000.
