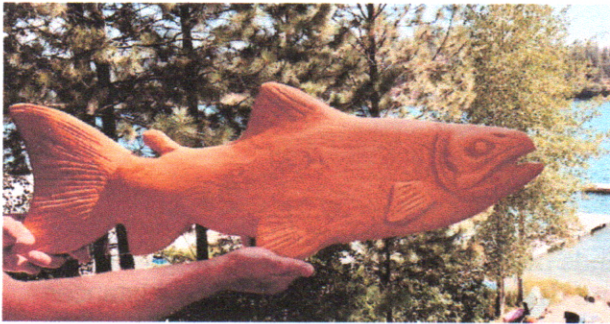

Accomplishments of Your Conservancy in 2019 & 2020

- During October 2020, we were able to purchase 2 large parcels in the center of the critically important Anderson Meadow wetland with the help of many donors, especially from Silver Beach, North Shore, and Sunset Beach. A huge accomplishment as we continue to pursue remaining parcels in this wetland.
- During Summer-Fall 2020, the Conservancy worked with Eagle Scout Nic Keener and his troop of volunteers to add historic trail signage, 4 new beautiful wooden benches, and clean-up of 6 miles of trails in the 43 acre Historic Morgan Wood at the north end of the lake.
- Throughout the Spring and Summer, Loon Lake Centennial Park near the old town was cleaned, pruned, mowed, and trimmed thanks to the hard work of 15 Volunteers..
- The 20 acre and 100' of shoreline addition to Shawl Wetland(near Shore Acres) purchased in 2019 was paid off thanks to donor responses to our summer fundraising events: our Summer Appeal letter, the late July "Float In", and a major donor event in August..."Summer's Eve on the Lawn"...which together raised the final \$50,000 needed! The Shawl Wetland now includes over 480' of waterfront wetland plus 40 acres of lowland and timbered filtering upland.
