We love Loon Lake! It is a beautiful place to share with family and friends. A place to enjoy fishing and swimming and boating and simply enjoying its beauty and peacefulness. These volunteers love Loon as well and recently spent a morning planting 200 Aspen Trees on a recently acquired Conservancy wetland property to restore part of what was once ruined by an attempt to fill and develop this wetland. Loon Lake is beautiful but also heavily developed. And there is much pressure to develop every remaining meadow and hilltop with housing and RV sites. Our public access launch sees 30-50 boats/day during prime fishing or summer days.

The mission of the Conservancy is to safeguard the few remaining wetlands and meadows, and close in uplands to keep the lake clean and usable for each of us and for our children and grandchildren. That they might be able to enjoy the same lake we love so much.
