Our annual celebration honoring the many Loon Lake Land Conservancy volunteers was a big success with more than 140 enthusiastic supporters in attendance on Aug. 5. Even the uninvited 20-minute downpour couldn't dampen the enthusiasm at this joyous event that raised more than \$50,000. An anonymous donor generously matched every donation of \$500 or more and that offer is still good for anyone looking to increase the total. Planning is already underway for he next Summer's Eve at the Lake event, which is tentatively set for Aug. 3, 2024.

Donations are used to purchase new wetland, upland properties and conservation easements. The middle section of wetland at Anderson Meadow is now owned by LLLC thanks to help from all donors and volunteers. Two more properties in Anderson Meadow need protection as well as wetland areas near the public boat launch.

Thirty acres of upland property near the northwest end of the lake has now been placed in a conservation easement to protect the area from future development in perpetuity. The 30 acres was donated by Randall and Jennifer Hansen, Loon Lake residents who have joined the LLLC Mission to protect and preserve our Lake.


## **Centennial Park cleanup**
