1. **2003 - Walt & Betty Davis Wetland** ...200 ft waterfront wetland drainage between Larson Beach & Lake Shore Homes
2. **2003 - Old Just Farm** ...15+ acre upland near Lake Shore Homes & Larson Beach
3. **2004 - Morgan Wood** ...40+ acre upland near Morgan Park & North Shore Homes
4. **2005 - Pearson Meadow Land Bank Conservation Easement** ... 11 acre wetland drainage located south of Lake Shore Homes and Silver Beach
5. **2008 - Bob & Nancy French - Little Loon Lake Conservation Easement** ...11+ acres near the Larson Beach bridge at Cedar Beau Bay & BNSF tracks
6. **2009 - Loon Lake Centennial Park historical property** Less than 1 acre in the original town of Loon Lake
7. **2017 - Bill & Jan Shawl Wetland** ...386 feet of waterfront wetland & 22 acres behind...next to Shore Acres Estates
8. **2019 - Bill & Jan Shawl Wetland Addition**...Additional 100 feet of waterfront wetland and 20 acres of timbered upland behind it added
9. **2020 - Center cut piece of Anderson Meadow purchased**... 250 feet of waterfront wetland and 40 acres of the meadow behind it ... plus another 20 acres of timbered upland behind it
10. **2021 - Anderson Meadow Addition**...Another 100 feet of waterfront wetland and 1 acre
11. **2023 - Ran & Jen Hansen Conservation Easement** ...30 acre hilltop upland above Arnold, Independence, & Totem Beaches

11 properties acquired thru Purchase or Conservation Easement

1,140 feet of Waterfront Protected ... 213 Acres (and counting) Preserved

Possible Future LLC Protections

1. **Anderson Meadow – another 40 acres west/ 400+ feet waterfront**
2. **Anderson Meadow – another 20 acres east/250+ feet waterfront**
3. **Anderson Meadow – close in 1 acre below road/100 feet waterfront**
4. **McVay Meadow – 70+ acres behind WDFW wetland ribbon; wetland drainage on NW end of lake**
5. **Meyer Farm Southern Edge – ephemeral streams and riparian acreage flowing into Loon**
6. **Carlson Bay Wetland – BNSF property – 100 feet waterfront 30' along lake**
